Caramel Apple Crisp

One sweet ingredient makes simple apple crisp sublime. Set aside a little extra caramel to drizzle on top!

1/2 cup caramel topping

¹/₂ teaspoon ground cinnamon

6 large apples, peeled and sliced (try a mix of apple varieties)

2/3 cup all-purpose flour

¹/₂ cup packed brown sugar

¹/₂ cup cold butter or margarine, cut in small pieces

2/3 cup quick-cooking oats

Optional – Vanilla ice cream or whipped cream Additional caramel sauce for topping

Heat oven to 374*.

In a large bowl, stir together the ½ cup caramel sauce with the cinnamon until blended. Add apple slices and toss until coated. Spread in an ungreased 8-inch square baking pan.

Caramel Apple Crisp, cont.

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In the same bowl, mix the flour and brown sugar. Cut in the butter with a pastry blender or with two table knives until the mixture looks like coarse crumbs.

Stir in the oats, then crumble the whole mixture over the apples.

Bake 45-50 minutes or until apples are tender and topping is golden brown.

Optional presentation - top with ice cream or whipped cream and drizzle with additional caramel sauce
